NAPLAN:

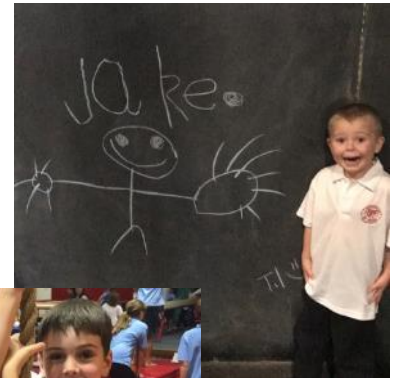
