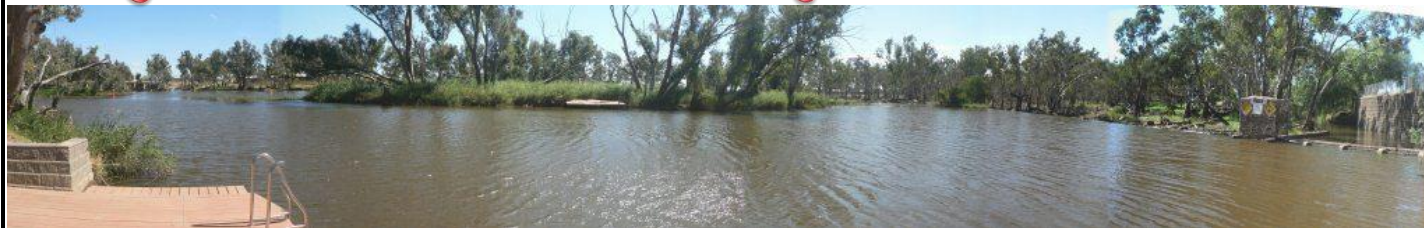

HEAD LICE:

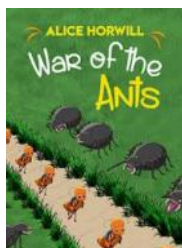
Head lice inspections will be conducted on Tuesday 27th March.
