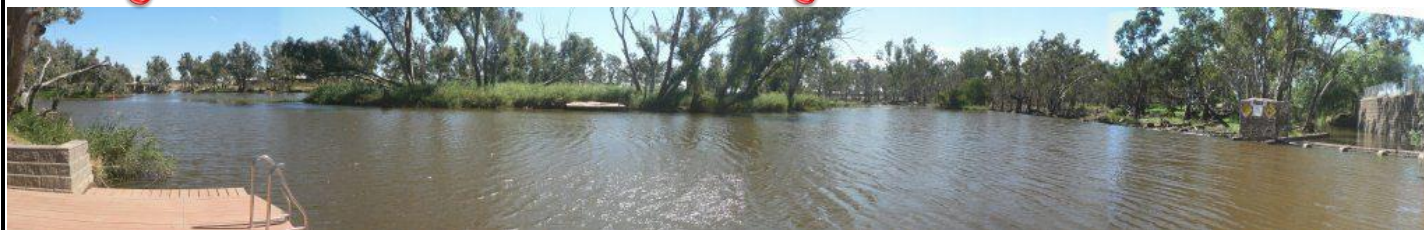

### uEducateUs:

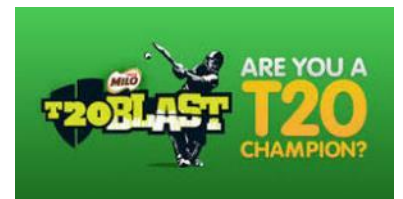
