EYE HEALTH PROGRAM:

It is well known that a student's vision is a major factor in his or her education. Vision needs to be clear and comfortable.

Unfortunately, many youngsters do not get around to having an eye examination and the Lions have undertaken the task of screening children from ages 3 to 8, with a follow-up examination when in Grade 6, to check developing myopia as they approach their teen years.

Local Lions who have undertaken training and assessed by the Lions Eye Health Program as being proficient to conduct vision screenings.

Lions Eye Health Program vision screening involves assessment of clarity of vision, eye co-ordination, colour vision and, with the aid of an infrared camera, assessment of short and long sightedness.

Bridgewater Primary School Bendigo Canoe Club Fundraiser

Our school has a fundraiser coming up on **Saturday the 19th of October** right here in Bridgewater. Last year we made \$868.85 from this day, (and like last year) these monies will go toward our kids school camp fees. This year's 4-6 camp cost is \$330 per student and Parents Club have committed to contribute \$70 per student to reduce this cost to our families. We will also be contributing to the 2-3 camp to Echuca when we know what the cost will be. This fundraiser will benefit all of our students and to make this day a success we will need contributions from all of our school families. We have been asked to provide a catering marquee at the Bendigo Canoe Club Community Paddle and will be selling hamburgers, sausages, cakes, slices, drinks and fruit.

We (the School Community) will need volunteers for the day and also baked goods to sell.
