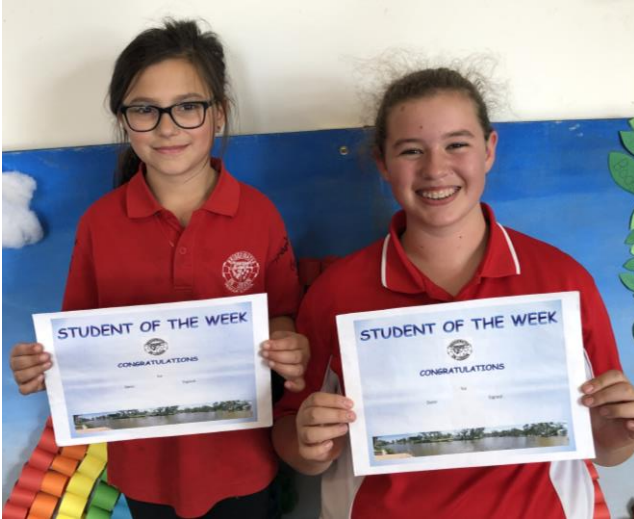


Students Of The Week
